

Challenge #1 DISCOVER

Collect FAMILY STORIES of <u>h</u>esed

- THINK about family stories you already know
- ASK your family to share stories
- LOOK through family photos to find acts of <u>h</u>esed caught on camera

Create your <u>H</u>ESED TREE



Make a Tree:

- **3D** Option: use found or recycled materials to create a tree (like plastic, foam or cardboard)
- 2D Option: draw the outline of a big tree on paper



Your Leaves:

 On the leaves, write words that remind you of each story from your family.

Who did the act of <u>h</u>esed? What did they do? Who did they help? What inspired them?



Your Roots & Trunk:

 Gather some family members to consider the stories on the leaves.

What acts of <u>h</u>esed are most important to your family? Do you see patterns? Are there acts of <u>h</u>esed you might want to try out together?

• Share the answers on the trunk of the tree.

Get creative in making a 2D or 3D landscape, surrounding your <u>h</u>esed tree with the following:






CLOUDS that show your dreams and hopes for a world of <u>h</u>esed.

HESED Challenge #3 EXPLORE

- Pick an area of need you want to learn more about.
 - Watch the 3 videos for one area of need (links on page 2). These videos will introduce you to people doing acts of <u>hesed</u> around the world.
- Start growing a world of <u>hesed!</u>
 - Use the example on page 3 to make a "seed packet" for the area of need you chose.
 - Name the "<u>h</u>esed plant" you want to grow and draw a picture of it.
 - Fold the paper into a seed packet. Tape or staple the sides but not the top.
 - Think about what you saw in the videos. On the back of the packet, make a list of the needs people have that match the area of need you chose.
 - On a separate piece of paper, start making a list of solutions of ways to take care of people's needs. Put this paper into your packet.
 - Save your seed packet for next week!



Make your Seeds: Use page 2 to create your seeds (your solutions to the needs). Your seeds will help grow a world of <u>h</u>esed!




